



Skyway's date of opening will be **Friday, May 8th**.

As you know conditions for us to open Skyway have been defined and set by the state of New York and local health authorities. With your best welfare in mind, we have pledged to comply to the very best of our ability. Entry onto Skyway's premises implies and expressly states your own agreement to adhere to these practices.

The main points of these practices are:

- 1). Skyway will be exclusively available to only self-contained RV units that have their own kitchen, bath, and sanitary equipment. No tent reservations can be taken at this time. RV rentals are still available.
- 2). **The governor's ruling to observe social distancing (six feet) is still in effect and must be complied with.** Also the governor's requirement to wear masks in public spaces, or while socializing with others who are not members of your immediate family, or who have not been sheltered with you. Any person who is sick or showing signs of sickness are asked not to come and will not be allowed entry.
- 3). Amenities that preclude the above are required by law to remain unavailable for the present time. This includes bathhouses, clubhouse, game room, playground, pool, and spa area. The laundromat will remain open, but as in many locations, the occupancy will be limited to the number of people allowed in at one time.
- 4). The county Board of Health has required us to temporarily delineate the boundaries of your campsite to make the social distancing easier for you to comply with. If you have a question about these delineations please contact the office.

We have been busy acquiring new supplies and adopting new systems and methods to make Skyway safe for you and your family in this environment. We strive to continue to learn and acquire whatever is needed to put you and your family's safety first.

We know that these governmental measures are for everyone's good, and believe that adhering to them will hasten the time when we can open all of Skyway's top-rated facilities for use.

Remember that it's still early in the camping year and as we continue to move, as a society, in the right direction, these restrictions may not be, and probably will not be, for the entire Skyway season.
